1. Any Prize-winning exhibits at previous Esk Shows are not eligible.
2. Maximum frame size of entries to be 93 x 62cm, including the frame.
3. Primary & High School artwork display more details in Primary & High School sections.
4. There is a limit of 3 entries per class for each exhibitor.
5. All canvasses and framed work must have wire/cord securely attached ready for hanging.
6. The Judge's decision is final.
7. The Chief Steward has the right to refuse to hang any exhibit deemed unsuitable and to change the nominated class if necessary.
8. Additional sub-classes may be added in the Classes 3 & 6 at the Chief Steward's discretion.
9. Bryden Hall will be closed to the public at 4.00pm.
10. All Exhibitors are to collect their item(s) between 4:30pm and 5:00pm Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2026.
