Special Regulations

1. Age of cattle will be taken as at 1 May 2026.
2. All animals must be registered in a Herd Book of the respective Breed Society. Registration certificate(s) must be made available to Stewards if requested.
3. All exhibitors MUST have Public Liability Insurance and to have same endorsed for travelling to Esk Show. Esk Show does not cover your liability.
4. Esk Show Society accepts no liability for any stock exhibited - the risk is of the exhibitor.
5. To lead an animal at the Esk Show, all children aged 12 years and under must be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age.
6. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure the leaders of their stock in judging rings are capable of exercising control over the animal in their care, to ensure public safety and safety of other exhibitors. Unruly animals will be disqualified at the Steward's discretion.
7. If the opinion of the judge, the cattle are unworthy of a prize, no award will be given.
8. All exhibits must be in and stalled by 10pm, Friday 22 May 2026 unless special consideration has been approved by the Chief Steward.
9. Stall allocation is a first in system. Please be courteous of space to ensure room for all exhibitors.

10. **All animals over 4 months must have a Nose Grip or Ring. Bulls 12 months and over must have a Nose Ring.**
11. **ALL CATTLE HOUSED OVERNIGHT MUST HAVE A NECK STRAP**
12. **All exhibits MUST always be haltered.**
13. Exhibitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction comply with all requirements of the current Workplace, Health and Safety Act. Esk Show Society holds each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during the show. **NOTICE TO ALL COMPETITORS: ALL COMPETITORS MUST PROVIDE A HEALTH DECLARATION/MOVEMENT FORM TO THE STEWARDS UPON ARRIVAL AT THE SHOWGROUNDS.**
14. In Cow classes, calves exhibited at foot Must be 8 months of age and Under.
15. **All cattle must be accompanied by a current National Vendor Declaration (NVD) and Certificate of Health Declaration.**
16. It is the responsibility of the owner or person in charge of the stock to ensure all cattle movement with regards to ticks has been met.
17. All stock must be free from ticks. Tick infested cattle will not be allowed to compete and must be removed from the Showgrounds. Free tick spraying is provided for cattle returning to clean country, please contact us prior to the event to ensure the clearer can be organised.
18. All cattle must have NLIS identification tags.
19. The exhibits will only be accepted from Brucellosis and Tuberculosis clean heard (status monitored negative, tested negative or confirmed free) recognised by the D.P.I
20. Johne's Disease - Cattle must not be introduced unless they comply with the conditions for animals to enter Queensland: a) They are from a non-restricted herd in a Johne's Disease protected or free zone OR b) They are from a check tested Negative or MN1 (Monitored Negative) or better herd in a Control or Residual Zone.
21. In addition to entry fees, the exhibitors are required to pay a \$50.00 stall cleaning deposit upon payment with their entry fees. The deposit is refundable providing that your stall is cleaned at the end of Saturday 23 May 2026 prior to departing the Esk Showgrounds and has been inspected by the Stud Beef Chief Steward. If the stalls are not cleaned, the exhibitor will be invoiced \$200.00 and will forfeit their deposit.
22. Grand Champion sash/trophy will only be awarded provided there is Senior & Junior.
23. Champion Prize Money will only be paid out if there is a minimum of 3 entries in the class.

The winner of Class 29 will be eligible to compete at the Regional Finals for the West Moreton and Brisbane Valley Sub Chamber. The Regional Finals will be hosted by Esk Show on Saturday 23 May 2026.

To be eligible for the State Finals, Competitors must comply with All Rules noted below. Paraders' competition is to determine the Paraders who presents and parades an animal before a judge most effectively.’

The Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. Beef Cattle Paraders Competition Rules

1. Paraders will parade their animal in a clockwise manner as is normal in cattle judging ring at the discretion of the Judge.
2. Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years of age on 1st May in the year of the State Final
3. Competitors under 17 years of age must have approval of parent/guardian to compete.
4. Competitors are to be a Queensland resident for three (3) months prior to competing or be attending an educational institution in Queensland unless they qualify under rule (5)
5. Competitors residing interstate who can provide an affinity with a Queensland Show are allowed entry provided they satisfy one (1) of the following criteria: (a) Their address has a Queensland postcode, (b) They have a Queensland phone number, (c) The competitor or their parents are actively members of that show
6. National winners are ineligible to compete.

Procedure for local show level competition

7. An entry form must be completed for all competitors.
8. Different age classes may be added to program for judging.
9. Paraders must wear a white dust coat and not display any name or logo at the Stewards discretion.
10. Beef Cattle Paraders may lead a steer or heifer or bull under 20 months.
11. For Safety reasons, judges are not permitted to ask competitors in Young Paraders' competitions to swap animals.
12. Cattle are to be presented in their natural, clean state - No glitter is permissible on animal or Paraders

School Herdsman Competition

Awarded to the School with the best overall result when judged on neatness of cattle and gear area, presentation of the stalls, conduct of the team, participation in events and the overall morale of the school.

To be judged the duration of the Friday and Saturday of the Esk Show.
